
Dear Mr. Pearsall:

We are advised that the subject application has been returned to the Examiner for prosecution on the merits and we will need to make an answer to the Office action mailed March 25, 1971. A response will be due in this Office action on or before February 14, 1972, and since the Office action is a Final Rejection, a decision will need to be made as to whether or not an appeal is pursued prior to that date also.

In my letter to Lyman dated June 9, 1971, a copy to you, I have asked Lyman to review the Mader and British patents to determine the correctness of the Examiner's position.
