Gentlemen:- Yours of the 21st inst. order #1386 received. We find you are now calling for a somewhat different spring than your order #1346 describes. It varies in diameter and size of wire. Your order #1346 gives the length 9 1/4" "When set." Our interpretation of this was, that when all of the set was taken out of the spring, the length should be 9 1/4". We understand you want order #1386 made 2 1/16" O. D., 5/16" Steel, and of such length as will when fully compressed, make 9 1/4" of solid coil. The order is so issued and shall have our very best attention.
