Thank you for letting me know of your interest in the position of Administrator of the Small Business Administration.

As you may have heard, since appointments to such positions are being made by the new Administration, the Colorado Republican Congressional delegation, under the guidance of Senator Armstrong, will be forwarding recommendations for qualified people to the new Administration.

Since a large number of Coloradans have indicated interest in such positions, preliminary screening and evaluation are being handled by a federal appointments review committee, chaired by Phil Winn, Republican State Chairman.

In this regard, the Committee has decided to use the standard form 171 as a uniform way of gathering some basic information. Enclosed is a copy, which should be returned to the Committee. In addition, you may want to send a copy directly to the office of the President-elect. The addresses are:
